The independence of this Board is critical to the exercise of its functions; and the Commission suspects that its omission from this list is but an oversight.  - 3. THE MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY; OR
 - 4. THE BOARD OF REVIEW OF THE DEPARTMENT.

Throughout this section, present references to "responsibilities" and "functions" are deleted as redundant in light of the references to "powers" and "duties".

In paragraph (1) of this subsection, the present phrase "in his discretion" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the use of the term
