(L) PROJECT.

"PROJECT" MEANS THE CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, RELOCATION OF ONE OR MORE SECTIONS OF PARTS OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM.

> Present references to various specific items that constitute a part of the State highway system, such as an "expressway" or a "bridge", are deleted as unnecessary. These are all included in the meaning of the term "highway" and, therefore, are by definition a part of the "State highway system", as defined in subsection (q) of this section.

- (d) RAILROAD GRADE SEPARATION.
- "RAILROAD GRADE SEPARATION" MEANS ANY (1) OVERPASS OR UNDERPASS THAT ELIMINATES A RAILROAD GRADE CROSSING.
  - (2) "RAILROAD GRADE SEPARATION" INCLUDES:
- THE OVERPASS AND UNDERPASS STRUCTURE AND (I) THE APPROACHES TO THEM:
- ANY RELATED ENTRANCE PLAZAS. (II)INTERCHANGES, CONNECTING HIGHWAYS, AND OTHER STRUCTURES: AND
- (III) ANY OTHER PROPERTY ACQUIRED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, OR USE OF THE RAILROAD GRADE SEPARATION.

(N) RCAD.

"ROAD" MEANS A HIGHWAY.

"SECONDARY HIGHWAY" MEANS A STATE HIGHWAY THAT IS NEITHER A PRIMARY HIGHWAY NOR INTERSTATE HIGHWAY.
