- ACTIVELY DEVOTED TO AGRICULTURAL OR FOREST USE. HOWEVER, THE BOARD MAY ADMIT PARCELS OF LESS THAN IEN ACRES THAT ARE CONTIGUOUS TO AN AGRICULTURAL FRESERVATION DISTRICT AND ARE IN A DESIGNATED AGRICULTURAL AREA.
- BOUNDARIES SHOULD FOLLOW AS CLOSELY AS FCSSIBLE, EXISTING PHYSICAL SEPARATIONS, SUCH AS STEERNS, VAILEYS, ROADS, ETC.
- AGRICULTURAL PRESERVATION DISTRICT IS 300 ACRES OF CONTIGUOUS LAND OR 500 ACRES OF NCNCONTIGUOUS LAND. HOWEVER, AFTER THE FORMATICN CF AN AGRICULTURAL PRESERVATION DISTRICT, THE BOASD SHALL ACCEPT ALL APPLICATIONS OF TEN OR MORE ACRES DURING THE OPEN ENROLLMENT PERIOD AND SHALL EXFAND THAT DISTRICT ACCORDINGLY.
- 4) AN AGRICULTURAL FRESERVATION DISTRICT SHALL REMAIN IN FORCE FOR A MINIMUM OF EIGHT YEARS.

 MEMBERS OF THE DISTRICT WHO HAVE NOT CONVEYED ANY DEVELOPMENT OPTIONS MAY WITHDRAW TEFIR LAND BY GIVING THE FOARD A ONE-YEAR NOTICE, PROVIDING THE PARCEL TO BE WITHDRAWN HAS BEEN IN THE DISTRICT A MINIMUM OF EIGHT YEARS. IN THE EVENT OF WITHDRAWALS FROM AN AGRICULTURAL PRESERVATION DISTRICT, THE REMAINING PROPERTY OWNERS MAY RETAIN THE DISTRICT REGARDLESS OF ACREAGE.
- 45) THE BOARD SHALL ACCEPT ALL APPLICATIONS
 FOR AN AGRICULTURAL PRESERVATION DISTRICT. THE BOARD
 SEALL REPORT ITS RECOMMENDATION TO THE COUNTY
 COMMISSIONERS. THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL ACCEPT OR
 REJECT THE BOARD'S PROPOSAL WITHIN 45 DAYS.
- (5) THE BOARD SHALL PROMOTE AN OPEN ENROLLMENT PROGRAM ANNUALLY TO ATTRACT NEW LANCOWNERS TO JOIN EXISTING OR NEW AGRICULTURAL PRESERVATION DISTRICTS.

275-

- (A) THE MINIMUM ACREAGE PERMITTED TO JOIN AN AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT IS TEN ACRES, EXCLUDING ANY ACREAGE UPON BUILD HAVE ACREAGE ARE LOCATED, THAT ARE ACTIVELY DEVOIED TO AGRICULTURAL OR FOREST USE. THE SOARD HAY ADMIT PERSONS WITH PARCELS LESS THAN THE ACRES TO AN AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT.
- (B) DISTRICT BOUNDARIES SHOULD FOLLOW, AS CLOSELY AS POSSIBLE, ELECTION DISTRICTS.
- (C) THE MINIMUM -- REQUIREMENT -- TO -- FORM -- AN AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT IS 300 ACRES OF CONTIGUOUS LAND AND 500 ACRES OF BONCONTIQUOUS LAND.
- (D) FEE BOARD SHALL REVIEW ACCELT APELICATIONS FOR AN AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT AND SHALL FITHER ACOPT, REFUSE, OR MODIFY THEM. THE BOARD SHALL REPORT FREE THEM.
