(A) THIS SUBHEADING APPLIES ONLY IN THE FOLLOWING COUNTIES BUT DOES NOT APPLY TO THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY PASSENGERS IN THE LIVING QUARTERS OF A MOTOR HOME, OR THE PASSENGERS OF A CHARTERED BUS, TAXICAB, OR OTHER VEHICLE IN TRANSIT IF THE OWNER OR OPERATOR HAS CONSENTED TO THE CONSUMPTION OF THE BEVERAGES.

(House Bill 506)

AN ACT concerning

Office of the Governor - Services to the Handicapped

FOR the purpose of creating an Office for the Coordination of Services to the Handicapped within the office of the Governor; requiring the appointment of a Director and providing that funding and personnel be provided to the Office for the Coordination of Services to the Handicapped; specifying its functions and duties; providing for appointment of a State Advisory Council for the Coordination of Services to the Handicapped and the appointment of its members; specifying the terms of the appointees to the Council; and specifying the functions of the Council.
