municipal taxes or charges to the same extent that these provisions and procedures are available to county tax collectors.

IN CALVERT COUNTY THE CCUNTY TAX COLLECTOR SHALL UTILIZE THE PRCVISIONS AND FROCEDURES OF THIS SUBTITLE UPON NOTIFICATION BY THE MUNICIPAL TAX COLLECTOR OF UNPAID MUNICIPAL TAXES OR CHARGES: AND PROCEED TO ACVERTISE AND SELL ANY REAL PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN ANY MUNICIPAL CCRPORATION IN CALVERT COUNTY UPON WHICH TAXES ARE DELINQUENT. THE MUNICIPAL CORFORATION, WITHIN WHICH THE PROPERTY BEING SOLD IS LOCATED, SHALL BUY IN AND HOLD-f-, AND PAY THE COSTS OF THE SAIE FCE-1- ANY PROPERTY OFFERED FOR SALE FOR NONFAYMENT OF MUNICIPAL TAXES ONLY FOR WHICH THERE IS NO OTHER FURCHASER. IF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION PURCHASES THE FROPERTY AT THE TAX SALE, THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION SHALL PAY TO CALVERT CCUNTY ANY TAXES OWED TO THE CCUNTY AND ANY COSTS INCURRED BY THE COUNTY IN THE SALE OF THAT PROPERTY. CALVERT COUNTY PURCHASES ANY PROFERTY LOCATED WITHIN A MUNICIPAL CCRPORATION IN THAT COUNTY WHICH IS EFING SOLD DELINQUENT TAXES THE COUNTY SHALL PAY TO THE MUNICIPAL CCRPORATION ANY TAXES OWED TO THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION FOR THAT PROPERTY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.
