(d) In Baltimore County the annual fee for such license shall be \$1,000. (House Bill 1638)

AN ACT concerning

Public Improvements - Maintenance and Repair

FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of General Services to establish and supervise a comprehensive and continuing maintenance and repair program for all State-operated public improvements.
