of employment security.]

- (6) THE SHERIFF MAY AFFOINT AS SPECIAL DEPUTY SHERIFFS ANY MEMBERS OF THE FOLICE FORCES OF THE TOWNS OF CECILTON, CHARLESTOWN, CHESAPEAKE CITY, ELKTON, NORTH EAST, PERRYVILLE, PORT DEPOSIT, OR RISING SUN OF ANY OTHER CORPORATE MUNICIPALITY WITHIN CECIL COUNTY. THESE SPECIAL DUTY SHERIFFS SHALL HAVE ALL OF THE FOWERS AND AUTHORITY OF THE DEFUTY SHERIFFS BOTE WITHIN AND WITHOUT THE TOWN IN WHICH THEY ARE MEMBERS OF THE FOLICE FORCE.
- (7) THE SHERIFF MAY AFFCINT AS SPECIAL DEPUTY SHERIFFS NOT MORE THAN 25 ADUIT VCLUNTEERS WHO SHALL SERVE WITHOUT PAY. UPON THE SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF TRAINING WHICH THE SHERIFF CONSIDERS AFFROPRIATE, THESE SPECIAL DEPUTY SHERIFFS SHALL HAVE ALL OF THE FOWERS AND AUTHORITY OF THE DEPUTY SHERIFFS AND FUNCTIONS AS THE SHERIFF'S GENERAL REPRESENTATIVES IN THE SAME MANNER AS HIS REGULAR DEPUTIES, ALL AT THE PLEASURE OF THE SHERIFF.
- IF LIABILITY, FALSE ARREST, AND WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE COVERAGE IS PROVIDED FOR THE REGULAR DEPUTY SHERIFFS, THE SAME COVERAGE SHALL BE PROVIDED FOR THE SPECIAL DEPUTIES PROVIDED FOR IN THIS PARAGRAPH.
- (8) THE SPECIAL DEPUTIES DESCRIBED IN FARAGRAPHS 6 AND 7 SHALL NOT BE CONSIDERED EMPLOYEES OF CECIL COUNTY AS SPECIAL DEPUTIES. ALL OTHER EMPLOYEES COVERED BY THIS SECTION ARE DECLARED TO BE EMPLOYEES OF CECIL COUNTY FOR PURPOSES OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHEF ENACTED, That new Section 35B be and it is hereby added to Article 101 Workmen's Compensation, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1964 Replacement Volume and 1976 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 101 - Workmen's Compensation

35E.

- (A) VOLUNTEER DEPUTY SHERIFFS OF CECIT CCUNTY, WHILE ACTUALLY ON DUTY, SHALL BE DEFTED WORKEN FOR WAGES AND ENGAGED IN EXTRA HAZARDOUS EMFLOYMENT WITHIN THE MEANING OF THIS ARTICLE. A DEPUTY SHERIFF OF CECIT COUNTY SHALL BE DEEMED TO BE ON DUTY WHENEVER HE PERFORMS WORK OR DUTY ASSIGNED HIM BY THE SHERIFF OF CECIT CCUNTY.
- (B) COMPENSATION SHALL SE BASED UPON THE SALARY OF MAGES RECEIVED BY THE DEPUTY SHERIFF OF CECIL CCUNTY IN HIS PRIVATE EMPLOYMENT; OR IF THE VOLUNTEER IS NOT EMPLOYED, ON THE SALARY OR WAGE LAST RECEIVED BY HIM; OF IF HE HAS NEVER BEEN EMPLOYED, COMPENSATION SHALL SE THE MINIMUM PROVIDED BY THIS ARTICLE.
