SUBTITLE 3. ACQUISITION AND DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY.

PART I. DEFINITIONS; GENERAL PROVISIONS.

8-301. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) COURT.

"COURT" MEANS THE SUPERIOR COURT OF BALTIMORE CITY OR THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR ANY OTHER COUNTY.

(C) LAND.

"LAND" MEANS REAL PROPERTY OR ANY INTEREST IN IT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added for clarity and simplicity.

(D) PLAT.

"PLAT" MEANS A PLAT OR A MAP.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language added to avoid unnecessary repetition in this subtitle of the phrase "plat or map".

8-302. GENERAL POWER TO ACQUIRE PRIVATE PROPERTY.
