## Right to Privacy

FOR the purpose of requesting the State Board of Education to study the various roles the public schools play in protecting the rights of privacy of students.

In the public schools, personal information is often solicited from students in the presence of other students. Children, especially younger children, may be unaware of the negative consequences of extensive self disclosure. Additionally, school personnel have significant power to affect the lives of students and their families.
