In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 138.

This bill establishes a certain order of priority for the disposition of the work release earnings of inmates of the Baltimore City Jail.

House Bill 372, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by Lieutenant Governor Blair Lee III in his capacity as Acting Governor on April 12, 1977, accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign Senate Bill 138.
