This bill authorizes certain investments of money seized in connection with certain arrests for gambling operations.

House Bill 377, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by Lieutenant Governor Blair Lee III in his capacity as Acting Governor on May 17, 1977, accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign Senate Bill 140.
