FOR the purpose of prohibiting the possession of counterfeit prescriptions; prohibiting certain people from obtaining or attempting to obtain prescription drugs in certain ways; and clarifying language.

Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 1014.

This bill prohibits the possession of counterfeit prescriptions and the obtaining or attempt to obtain prescription drugs in certain ways.

House Bill 1701, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by Lieutenant Governor Elair Lee III in his capacity as Acting Governor on May 17, 1977, accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore, it is unnecessary for me to sign Senate Bill 1014.
