For the purpose of adding a new section to the Constitution to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to pledge revenue derived from the parking of motor vehicles for the payment of revenue bonds issued in connection with parking facilities to be owned by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore and submitting this amendment to the qualified voters of the State of Maryland for their adoption or rejection.

And it is hereby certified that at said election, 338,028 votes were cast for the adoption of said Chapter 552 and 270,202 votes were cast against the adoption of said Chapter 552, the said Chapter 552 of the Acts of 1976 has therefore been ratified by the qualified voters of the State of Maryland.
