

ORDERS.

THE REGULATIONS AND ORDERS OF THE ADMINISTRATION:

(1) MAY NOT PROHIBIT OR BE CONSTRUED TO CONSTITUTE A CONTRACT PROHIBITING ANY PAYMENT REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION; AND

(2) ARE EXPRESSLY WAIVED TO THE EXTENT NECESSARY TO AUTHORIZE ANY PAYMENT REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION.

(D) DUTY OF UTILITY.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT RELIEVE THE OWNER OF ANY UTILITY FROM ANY LEGAL OR CONTRACTUAL OBLIGATION TO COMPLY PROMPTLY WITH ANY ORDER OR REQUEST OF THE ADMINISTRATION TO PERFORM THE WORK NECESSARY TO RELOCATE ITS FACILITIES.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 89B, §76(7).

Present Art. 89B, §76(6), which was superseded by enactment of this provision in 1967, is deleted as obsolete and redundant.

8-507. COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL URBAN AREA HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION FUNDS.

(A) DEFINITIONS.

(1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "MUNICIPALITY" MEANS ANY MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN THIS STATE THAT IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE FEDERAL-AID URBAN FUNDS.

(3) "URBAN AREA" MEANS AN AREA WITH BOUNDARIES FIXED BY THE ADMINISTRATION THAT INCLUDES AND IS ADJACENT TO A MUNICIPALITY OR OTHER URBAN PLACE HAVING A POPULATION OF AT LEAST 5,000, AS DETERMINED BY THE LATEST FEDERAL CENSUS.

(B) FUNDS ESTABLISHED.

(1) THERE IS A COUNTY HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION FUND IN THE TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND.

(2) THERE IS A MUNICIPALITY-URBAN AREA HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION FUND IN THE TRANSPORTATION TRUST FUND.

(C) COMPOSITION OF FUNDS.
