RESOLUTION NO. 66

RESOLUTION of the Mayor and City Council of Cumberland, Maryland, adopted in pursuance of the authority contained in Article 11-E of the Constitution of the State of Maryland, and Section 13 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, entitled "Municipal Corporations", as said Section was enacted by Chapter 423 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, 1955, entitled "A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF CUMBERLAND, MARYLAND (1966 EDITION), BY REPEALING AND REENACTING, WITH AMENDMENTS, SECTION 192 RELATING TO APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE
