RESOLUTION NO. 46 OF TOWN OF EASTON TO AMEND THE CHARTER

Resolution of the Town of Easton, adopted pursuant to the authority of Maryland Constitution, Art. XI-E, entitled "Municipal Corporations", "Home Rule", and Maryland Code (1957, 1973 Repl. Vol.) Art. 23A, § 13, entitled, "Corporations-Municipal", "Home Rule", "Charter Amendments", "Initiation by legislative body", to amend Article II, Section 19 of the Charter of the Town of Easton to provide that the \$200,000.00 limitation on the sale and purchase of property without a referendum shall not apply to any sale or purchase made, the financing of which is guaranteed or otherwise provided by the Maryland Industrial Financing Authority Act or similar laws of the State of Maryland.
