RESOLUTION NUMBER 325

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GREENBELT ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF ARTICLE 11E OF THE CONSTITUTION OF MARYLAND AND SECTION 13 OF ARTICLE 23A OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND (1957 EDITION AS AMENDED), TITLE "CORPORATION-MUNICIPAL", SUB-TITLE "HOME RULE", TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF GREENBELT, MARYLAND, SAID CHARTER BEING SECTION 40 OF ARTICLE 17 OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF MARYLAND (1963 EDITION AS AMENDED) AND CONTAINING IN WHOLE OR IN PART THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF GREENBELT, BY REPEALING AND REENACTING WITH AMENDMENTS SECTION 59, TITLE "CONTRACTS OVER ONE YEAR", TO PROVIDE THAT A MORTGAGE CONTRACT WITH THE STATE OF MARYLAND RELATING TO THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A FEDERALLY SUBSIDIZED HOUSING PROJECT FOR ELDERLY PERSONS MAY EXTEND FOR A PERIOD OF NOT MORE THAN FORTY YEARS.

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GREENBELT ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF ARTICLE 11E OF THE CONSTITUTION OF MARYLAND AND SECTION 13 OF ARTICLE 23A OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND (1957 EDITION AS AMENDED), TITLE "CORPORATION-MUNICIPAL", SUB-TITLE "HOME RULE", TO AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF GREENBELT, MARYLAND, SAID CHARTER BEING SECTION 40 OF ARTICLE 17 OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF MARYLAND (1963 EDITION AS AMENDED) AND CONTAINING IN WHOLE OR IN PART THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF GREENBELT REPEALING AND REENACTING WITH AMENDMENTS SECTION 54, TITLE "CUSTODY OF MONEYS," TO REQUIRE THE DEPOSIT OF MONEYS RECEIVED BY THE CITY WITH FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS HAVING ACCOUNT INSURED BY THE FEDERAL DEPOSIT INSURANCE CORPORATION OR THE FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN INSURANCE CORPORATION OR THE MARYLAND SAVINGS-SHARE INSURANCE CORPORATION.
