

Annotated Code of Maryland, 1957 Edition, as amended, had been complied with, a resolution was introduced on May 24, 1976, proposing to change the boundaries as requested in the Petition for Annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council has provided a proposed outline for the extension of services and public facilities into the area proposed to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, thereafter a public notice of said Resolution was published not fewer than four times at not less than weekly intervals in the Montgomery County Sentinel, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Rockville and the area to be annexed, the said notice specifying that a public hearing would be held on said Resolution in the Council Chamber, Rockville City Hall, by the Mayor and Council at 8:30 P.M. on August 9, 1976; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council conducted a public hearing on said Resolution at the time and place provided for in said advertisement; and said matter having been fully considered and deliberated by the Mayor and Council, and said Council having decided that the aforesaid Resolution should be adopted;

Resolution No. 5-77

RESOLUTION: To Provide for the Enlarging of the Corporate Boundaries of the City of Rockville to include 3.80266 Acres of Land known as The Montgomery County Animal Shelter.

WHEREAS, Heretofore a Petition has been presented to the Mayor and Council of Rockville proposing to enlarge the corporate boundaries of the City of Rockville so as to include a tract of land known as The Montgomery County Animal Shelter, containing 3.80266 acres, more or less, located east of Gude Drive and east of the existing corporate boundaries; and

WHEREAS, Upon verification that the requirements of Section 19, subsection (c) of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, 1957 Edition, as amended, had been complied with, a resolution was introduced on October 4, 1976, proposing to change the boundaries as requested in the Petition for Annexation; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council has provided a proposed outlined for the extension of services and
