WHEREAS, existing litigation has cast uncertainty surrounding the validity of the enactment of certain sections of the Anne Arundel County Code relating to special exceptions for the operation of sanitary landfills by Anne Arundel County and the City of Annapolis, it is the purpose of this Ordinance to rectify any pre-existing defects in the enactment of those sections.
