respect to training; and to allow a junior or an active rescue squadsman to ride upon an ambulance or rescue squad truck, having no primary rescue responsibility, if said junior or active rescue squadsman has completed a standard first aid and personal safety course and a cardiopulmonary resuscitation course, or such equivalent courses as approved by the Fire Commission.

### A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT to amend Section 27-16 and Section 27-17 of the Public Local Laws for Prince George's County, Maryland, to make changes in the boundary lines of the 16th and 17th Election Districts in Prince George's County and to clarify the names of the existing boundaries.

# Bill No. CB-77-1976 Introduced April 27, 1976

#### A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT to add new Sections 75-5 through 75-13 to Subtitle 75, titled "Taxes" of the code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's County, 1963 Edition and 1967 Supplement, as amended, to impose a use and occupancy tax upon any sum of money charged for the use and occupancy of specified rental multi-family dwelling units within the County; to enact certain other related provisions, including penalties, in aid of the administration, collection and enforcement of such use and occupancy tax; to provide for specified exemptions from such tax; and for related purposes.

## Bill No. CB-86-1976 Introduced July 20, 1976

#### AN EMERGENCY BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT to add a new Section 75—42 14 in Subtitle 75 titled "Taxes" of the Public Local Laws of Prince George's County, to provide a refund for taxes paid on any assessment which has become final in Prince George's County on non-existent property.
