

SUBTITLE 2. MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION.

2-201. "COMMISSION" DEFINED.

IN THIS SUBTITLE, "COMMISSION" MEANS THE MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language added to avoid unnecessary repetition in this subtitle of the full title of the Commission.

2-202. COMMISSION ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS A MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION IN THE DEPARTMENT.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the first clause of Art. 41, §208D(a).

It is set forth as a separate section for emphasis.

2-203. COMPOSITION; QUALIFICATIONS; TENURE; VACANCIES.

(A) COMPOSITION.

THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING 17 MEMBERS:

(1) AS EX OFFICIO MEMBERS, THE SEVEN REGIONAL MEMBERS OF THE STATE ROADS COMMISSION; AND

(2) TEN MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVICE OF THE SECRETARY.

(B) APPOINTEES--QUALIFICATIONS.

AN APPOINTED MEMBER MAY NOT BE AN OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT. EACH APPOINTED MEMBER SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE AND HAVE INTEREST AND, PREFERABLY, EXPERIENCE IN AT LEAST ONE OF THE FIELDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE DEPARTMENT.

(C) APPOINTEES--TENURE; VACANCIES.

(1) EACH APPOINTED MEMBER SERVES FOR A TERM OF 3 YEARS AND UNTIL HIS SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES. THE TERMS OF APPOINTED MEMBERS SHALL BE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE ORIGINAL APPOINTMENTS TO THE COMMISSION, THREE OF WHICH WERE MADE FOR A 3-YEAR TERM, FOUR OF WHICH WERE MADE FOR A 2-YEAR TERM, AND THREE OF WHICH WERE MADE FOR A 1-YEAR TERM.

(2) A MEMBER APPOINTED TO FILL A VACANCY IN AN UNEXPIRED TERM SERVES ONLY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THAT
