TITLE 10. TRANSPORTATION COMPACTS.

SUBTITLE 1. AVIATION - POTOMAC HIGHLANDS AIRPORT AUTHORITY.

10-101. APPLICABILITY OF TITLE 5 DEFINITIONS.

A WORD USED IN THE COMPACT SET FORTH IN THIS SUBTITLE, UNLESS THE CONTEXT CLEARLY REQUIRES OTHERWISE, HAS THE SAME MEANING AS IS INDICATED BY A DEFINITION OF THE WORD IN §5-101 OF THIS ARTICLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language added to avoid unnecessary repetition of the various definitions contained in former Art. 1A of the Code, now appearing in §5-101 of this article. Since the Compact originally was enacted as part of former Art. 1A, these definitions apparently were intended to apply to it. See, e.g., §5-101 (e) ("aircraft") and §5-101(h) ("airport facility").

10-102. ENACTMENT OF COMPACT.

AN INTERSTATE COMPACT, SUBSTANTIALLY AS IT APPEARS IN §10-103 OF THIS SUBTITLE, IS ENACTED INTO LAW AND ENTERED INTO WITH THE STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived from Section 3 of Ch. 253, Acts of 1976, and patterned after somewhat similar provisions appearing elsewhere in this article; see, e.g., §§ 10-202 and 22-502 of this article.

Section 3. of Ch. 253, Acts of 1976, provides, in full, that: "[T]his Act may not take effect until a similar Act is passed by the State of West Virginia; ... the State of West Virginia is requested to concur in this Act of the General Assembly of Maryland by the passage of a similar Act; and ... thereupon the Governor of the State of Maryland shall issue a proclamation declaring this Act valid and
