11-142. OPERATOR.

"OPERATOR", AS USED IN REFERENCE TO A VEHICLE, MEANS -A DRIVER, AS DEFINED IN THIS SUBTITLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language substituted for Art. 66 1/2, § 1-156.

As presently defined, "driver" and "operator" are virtually synonymous terms. The substitution here of a simple cross-reference makes that construction more apparent. See, also, revisor's note to §11-114 of this subtitle.

11-143. OWNER.

"OWN ER", AS USED IN REFERENCE TO A VEHICLE:

- (1) MEANS A PERSON WHO HAS THE PROPERTY IN OR TITLE TO THE VEHICLE;
- (2) INCLUDES A PERSON WHO, SUBJECT TO A SECURITY INTEREST IN ANOTHER PERSON, IS ENTITLED TO THE USE AND POSSESSION OF THE VEHICLE; AND
- (3) DOES NOT INCLUDE A LESSEE UNDER A LEASE NOT INTENDED AS SECURITY.
