

"USED VEHICLE" MEANS ANY VEHICLE THAT IS NOT A NEW VEHICLE, AS DEFINED IN THIS SUBTITLE.

The more general term "vehicle" is substituted for "motor vehicle" to conform to the counterpart definition of "new vehicle" and the use of the term in the Maryland Vehicle Law.

11-176. VEHICLE.

"VEHICLE" MEANS ANY DEVICE IN, ON, OR BY WHICH ANY INDIVIDUAL OR PROPERTY IS OR MIGHT BE TRANSPORTED OR TOWED ON A HIGHWAY.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Art. 66 1/2, §1-209.

The only changes are in style.

11-177. VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER.

"VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER" MEANS THE NUMERALS, LETTERS, OR COMBINATION OF NUMERALS AND LETTERS ON A VEHICLE THAT THE ADMINISTRATION DESIGNATES FOR THE PURPOSE OF IDENTIFYING THE VEHICLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Art. 66 1/2, §1-134.

The better-known and more commonly accepted term "vehicle identification number" is substituted for the present "identifying number" as the defined term.

The only other changes are in style.

GENERAL REVISOR'S NOTE:

In revising this subtitle, the Commission to Revise the Annotated Code included in it only those definitions or present Art. 66 1/2, Subtitle 1, that have general applicability throughout various titles of the Maryland Vehicle Law. The rest of these definitions have been deleted or transferred as noted below.
