REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived from Art. 66 1/2, §3-418.

In light of Art. 76A of the Code and current practice, the section is revised to relate to information listings, generally, and not only - as in present §3-418 - "vehicle registration information".

In subsection (c) of this section, the phrase "or otherwise using" is added for clarity.

The only other changes are in style.

12-113. SAME - CERTIFIED COPIES; USE IN JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS.

(A) CERTIFICATION OF RECORDS.

(1) THE ADMINISTRATOR OR ANY OTHER OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF THE ADMINISTRATION DESIGNATED BY THE ADMINISTRATOR MAY PREPARE AND DELIVER ON REQUEST A CERTIFIED COPY OF ANY RECORD OF THE ADMINISTRATION.

(2) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY CHARGE A FEE OF \$1 FOR EACH DOCUMENT IT CERTIFIES.

(B) ADMISSIBILITY OF CERTIFIED COPY IN JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS; COMPLIANCE WITH SUBPOENA.

(1) A CERTIFIED COPY OF ANY RECORD OF THE ADMINISTRATION IS ADMISSIBLE IN ANY JUDICIAL PROCEEDING IN THE SAME MANNER AS THE ORIGINAL OF THE RECORD.

(2) IF A SUBPOENA IS ISSUED TO THE ADMINISTRATOR OR ANY OTHER OFFICIAL OR EMPLOYEE OF THE ADMINISTRATION FOR THE PRODUCTION IN ANY JUDICIAL PROCEEDING OF THE ORIGINAL OR A COPY OF ANY BOOK, PAPER, ENTRY, RECORD, PROCEEDING, OR OTHER DOCUMENT OF THE ADMINISTRATION:

(I) THE ADMINISTRATOR OR OTHER OFFICIAL OR EMPLOYEE OF THE ADMINISTRATION NEED NOT APPEAR PERSONALLY; AND

(II) SUBMISSION OF A CERTIFIED COPY OF PHOTOSTAT OF THE REQUESTED DOCUMENT IS FULL COMPLIANCE
