SUBTITLE 3. IDENTIFICATION CARDS; DONORS UNDER UNIFORM ANATOMICAL GIFT ACT.

12-301. SPECIAL IDENTIFICATION CARDS.

(A) ISSUANCE OF CARD.

ON REQUEST, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ISSUE A SPECIAL IDENTIFICATION CARD TO ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO:

- (1) IS A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE; AND
- (2) DOES NOT HAVE A DRIVER'S LICENSE.

(B) FEE.

(1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A SPECIAL IDENTIFICATION CARD IS \$2.

(2) A FEE IS NOT REQUIRED IF THE APPLICANT FOR THE CARD:

- (I) IS 65 YEARS OLD OR OLDER;
- (II) IS LEGALLY BLIND;
- (III) HAS PERMANENTLY LOST THE USE OF A LEG OR AN ARM; OR
- (IV) IS DISABLED SO SEVERELY THAT THE APPLICANT CANNOT MOVE WITHOUT THE AID OF CRUTCHES OR A WHEELCHAIR.

(C) SURRENDER OF AGE OF MAJORITY IDENTIFICATION CARD.

IF AN AGE OF MAJORITY IDENTIFICATION CARD HAS BEEN ISSUED UNDER §12-302 OF THIS SUBTITLE TO AN APPLICANT FOR A SPECIAL IDENTIFICATION CARD, THE APPLICANT SHALL SURRENDER THE AGE OF MAJORITY IDENTIFICATION CARD TO THE ADMINISTRATION BEFORE A SPECIAL IDENTIFICATION CARD IS ISSUED.

(D) FRAUD AND MISREPRESENTATION PROHIBITED.

A PERSON MAY NOT COMMIT ANY FRAUD OR MAKE ANY MISREPRESENTATION IN APPLYING FOR OR USING A SPECIAL IDENTIFICATION CARD.

(E) FORM AND CONTENTS OF CARD.

A SPECIAL IDENTIFICATION CARD SHALL BE SIMILAR IN SIZE, SHAPE, AND DESIGN TO A DRIVER'S LICENSE. HOWEVER,
