SUBTITLE 4. REGISTRATION OF VEHICLES.

PART I. IN GENERAL.

13-401. DRIVING UNREGISTERED VEHICLE.

(A) WHEN DRIVING PROHIBITED.

AS TO ANY VEHICLE REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED UNDER THIS TITLE, A PERSON MAY NOT DRIVE THE VEHICLE ON ANY HIGHWAY IN THIS STATE AND THE OWNER OF THE VEHICLE MAY NOT KNOWINGLY PERMIT IT TO BE DRIVEN ON ANY HIGHWAY IN THIS STATE, IF:

(1) THE VEHICLE IS NOT REGISTERED OR THE REQUIRED REGISTRATION FEE HAS NOT BEEN PAID; OR

(2) THE REGISTRATION OF THE VEHICLE IS ~~CANCELLED~~ CANCELED, SUSPENDED, OR REVOKED.

(B) DRIVING PENDING COMPLETE REGISTRATION.

IF AN APPLICATION ACCOMPANIED BY THE REQUIRED FEE HAS BEEN MADE FOR REGISTRATION OF A VEHICLE, THE VEHICLE MAY BE DRIVEN TEMPORARILY PENDING COMPLETE REGISTRATION:

(1) ON DISPLAYING AN AUTHENTICATED REGISTRATION CARD; OR

(2) OTHERWISE UNDER RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE ADMINISTRATOR.
