In subsection (b) of this section, as elsewhere in this article, phrases such as "lawfully entitled" are deleted as unnecessary.

The only other changes are in style.

As to subsection (c) of this section, the referenced previsions as to persons authorized to sign for a certificate of title are set forth in §13-104(c) of this title.

13-404. COUNTY TREASURERS AS AGENTS FOR ADMINISTRATION; SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR CERTAIN COUNTIES.
