13-408. ADMINISTRATION TO ISSUE REGISTRATION CARD.

WHEN IT REGISTERS A VEHICLE, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ISSUE AND DELIVER TO THE CWNER A REGISTRATION CARD THAT CONTAINS:

- (1) THE DATE ISSUED;
- (2) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE OWNER:
- (3) THE REGISTRATION NUMBER ASSIGNED BY THE ADMINISTRATION TO THE VEHICLE; AND
- (4) SUCH DESCRIPTION OF THE VEHICLE AS THE ADMINISTRATOR DETERMINES.

13-409. REGISTRATION CARD TO BE CAFRIED AND EXHIBITED ON DEMAND OF POLICE OFFICER.

(A) IN GENERAL.

AT ALL TIMES, EACH REGISTRATION CARD SHALL BE CARRIED:

- (1) IN THE VEHICLE TO WHICH IT REFERS: OR
- (2) BY THE INDIVIDUAL DRIVING OR IN CONTROL OF THE VEHICLE, WHO SHALL DISPLAY IT, ON DEMAND, TO ANY POLICE OFFICER WHO IDENTIFIES HIMSELF AS SUCH.
 - (B) EXCEPTION.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY IF THE CARD IS BEING USED TO APPLY FOR THE TRANSFER OF REGISTRATION OF THE VEHICLE.
