SUBTITLE 6. SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES.

PART I. TEMPORARY REGISTRATION PLATES FOR BUYERS OF VEHICLES.

13-601. APPLICATION BY DEALER; FEE.

THE ADMINISTRATION MAY DESIGN TEMPORARY REGISTRATION PLATES AND FURNISH THEM TO ANY LICENSED DEALER WHO:

(1) ON THE FORM THAT THE ADMINISTRATION REQUIRES, APPLIES FOR AT LEAST FIVE OF THESE PLATES; AND

(2) WITH THE APPLICATION, SUBMITS A FEE OF 50 CENTS FOR EACH PLATE.
