13-602. ISSUANCE OF PLATES TO BUYER.

(A) AUTHORITY OF DEALER TO ISSUE.

(1) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS PART, A LICENSED DEALER MAY ISSUE ONE TEMPORARY REGISTRATION PLATE FOR A VEHICLE TO THE PERSON WHO BUYS THE VEHICLE FROM THE DEALER, WHETHER OR NOT THE VEHICLE IS TO BE REGISTERED IN THIS STATE.

(2) THE DEALER MAY NOT ISSUE MORE THAN ONE TEMPORARY REGISTRATION FOR ANY VEHICLE.

(B) APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY REGISTRATION.

(1) BEFORE A TEMPORARY REGISTRATION PLATE MAY BE ISSUED FOR A VEHICLE, THE BUYER OF THE VEHICLE SHALL COMPLETE AND DELIVER TO THE DEALER A TEMPORARY REGISTRATION PLATE APPLICATION, ON THE FORM THAT THE ADMINISTRATION REQUIRES.

(2) ON THE SAME DAY THAT A DEALER ISSUES A TEMPORARY REGISTRATION PLATE FOR A VEHICLE, THE DEALER SHALL SEND TO THE ADMINISTRATION A COPY OF THE TEMPORARY REGISTRATION PLATE APPLICATION COMPLETED BY THE BUYER OF THE VEHICLE.

13-603. DEALER'S DUTIES AS TO ANNUAL REGISTRATION.

(A) IF BUYER REQUESTS REGISTRATION.

ON REQUEST OF THE BUYER OF A VEHICLE TO WHOM THE DEALER HAS ISSUED A TEMPORARY REGISTRATION PLATE, THE DEALER IMMEDIATELY SHALL SEND TO THE ADMINISTRATION:

(1) AN APPLICATION COMPLETED BY THE BUYER FOR THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION OF THE VEHICLE; AND

(2) THE REQUIRED REGISTRATION FEE COLLECTED FROM THE BUYER.

(B) IF BUYER MAKES NO REQUEST.

IF THE DEALER IS NOT REQUESTED TO SEND AN APPLICATION TO THE ADMINISTRATION FOR ANNUAL REGISTRATION OF THE VEHICLE, THE DEALER SHALL NOTIFY THE ADMINISTRATION OF THIS FACT WHEN HE COMPLIES WITH
