PART II. CANCELLATION, SUSPENSION, OR REVOCATION.

13-705. SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF REGISTRATION OR CERTIFICATE OF TITLE IN GENERAL.

(A) AUTHORITY OF ADMINISTRATION TO SUSPEND OR REVOKE.

(1) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE REGISTRATION OR CERTIFICATE OF TITLE OF ANY VEHICLE IF THE ADMINISTRATION:

(I) IS SATISFIED THAT THE REGISTRATION OR CERTIFICATE WAS FRAUDULENTLY OBTAINED OR ERRONEOUSLY ISSUED;

(II) DETERMINES THAT THE REQUIRED FEE HAS NOT BEEN PAID AFTER REASONABLE NOTICE AND DEMAND; OR

(III) IS SO AUTHORIZED UNDER ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW.

(2) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY SUSPEND OR REVOKE THE REGISTRATION OF A VEHICLE IF:

(I) THE ADMINISTRATION DETERMINES THAT THE VEHICLE IS MECHANICALLY UNFIT OR UNSAFE TO BE OPERATED ON THE HIGHWAYS;

(II) THE VEHICLE HAS BEEN DISMANTLED OR WRECKED; OR

(III) A REGISTRATION CARD OR REGISTRATION PLATE NOT ISSUED FOR THAT VEHICLE IS DISPLAYED ON OR FOR THE VEHICLE.

(B) RIGHT OF APPEAL.

A SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION UNDER THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO THE RIGHT OF APPEAL AS FOLLOWS:

(1) BY A RESIDENT:

(I) IF HE RESIDES OR HAS HIS PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS IN BALTIMORE CITY, TO THE BALTIMORE CITY COURT; OR

(II) IF HE RESIDES OR HAS HIS PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS IN ANY OTHER COUNTY, TO THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR THAT COUNTY; AND
