

THE CERTIFICATE OF TITLE OR THE REGISTRATION OF A VEHICLE, THE OWNER OR PERSON IN POSSESSION OF THE EVIDENCES OF THE TITLE OR THE EVIDENCES OF THE REGISTRATION, INCLUDING THE REGISTRATION CARD AND REGISTRATION PLATES, IMMEDIATELY SHALL RETURN THEM TO THE ADMINISTRATION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Art. 66 1/2, §3-706.

The present reference to a "nonresident or other permit" is deleted as obsolete; in this regard, see revisor's note to §13-705 of this subtitle.

The present reference to the return of evidence of a suspended or revoked license of a dealer or wrecker is transferred to §15-110 of this article.

The present reference to a violation of this section as being a "misdemeanor" is deleted as unnecessary in light of §27-101 of this article.

The only other changes are in style.

13-709. EFFECT OF CANCELLATION, SUSPENSION, OR REVOCATION OF REGISTRATION ON PROPERTY RIGHTS.

THE CANCELLATION, SUSPENSION, OR REVOCATION OF THE REGISTRATION OF A VEHICLE DOES NOT AFFECT THE STATUS OF THE TITLE TO OR ANY PROPERTY RIGHTS IN THE VEHICLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 66 1/2, §7-102 (c).

GENERAL REVISOR'S NOTE:

In revising this subtitle, the Commission to Revise the Annotated Code has deleted present Art. 66 1/2, §3-707, as to the right of the Administration to seize evidences of registration or title. The section is unnecessary in light of the broad provisions of §12-110 of this article to the same effect.

SUBTITLE 8. TITLING FEES AND TAXES.

PART I. FEES FOR CERTIFICATES OF TITLE.

13-801. WHEN AND TO WHOM FEES PAYABLE.

THE FEES SPECIFIED IN THIS PART FOR A CERTIFICATE OF TITLE SHALL BE PAID TO THE ADMINISTRATION BEFORE ISSUANCE OF THE CERTIFICATE.
