13-804. FUNDS FOR ENFORCEMENT OF VEHICLE INSPECTION LAW.

FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENFORCING TITLE 23 OF THIS ARTICLE ~~4~~["INSPECTION OF USED VEHICLES AND WARNINGS FOR DEFECTIVE EQUIPMENT"], THE ADMINISTRATION MAY RETAIN AND USE \$2 FROM EACH FEE PAID UNDER §13-802(1) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

13-805. FEE FOR DUPLICATE CERTIFICATE OF TITLE.

FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A DUPLICATE CERTIFICATE OF TITLE, ISSUED UNDER §13-111 OF THIS TITLE TO REPLACE A LOST, STOLEN, OR DAMAGED CERTIFICATE OF TITLE, THE FEE IS \$1.

13-808. WHEN AND TO WHOM TAX PAYABLE.

THE EXCISE TAXES IMPOSED BY THIS PART FOR A VEHICLE SHALL BE PAID TO THE ADMINISTRATION:

(1) BEFORE THE ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE OF TITLE FOR THAT VEHICLE; OR
