

(A) "FARM TRUCK" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION, "FARM TRUCK" MEANS A FARM VEHICLE THAT:

(1) IS A CLASS E (TRUCK) VEHICLE; AND

(2) HAS A SHIPPING WEIGHT OF ITS CHASSIS AND BATTERY, AS CERTIFIED BY THE MANUFACTURER, OF MORE THAN 3/4 TON.

(B) APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION.

ON APPLICATION, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ISSUE A SPECIAL CLASS E "FARM TRUCK REGISTRATION" TO ANY APPLICANT WHO CERTIFIES:

(1) THAT THE APPLICANT IS A FARMER; AND

(2) THAT THE VEHICLE FOR WHICH THE APPLICATION IS MADE IS A FARM TRUCK, SPECIFYING ITS PROPOSED USE.

(C) ANNUAL FEE.

FOR EACH VEHICLE REGISTERED UNDER THIS SECTION, THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE IS BASED ON THE SHIPPING WEIGHT OF ITS CHASSIS AND BATTERY, AS CERTIFIED BY THE MANUFACTURER, WITH MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT LIMITATIONS FOR THE VEHICLE, AS FOLLOWS:

(D) PROHIBITED USES.

A VEHICLE REGISTERED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE USED:

(1) FOR HIRE; OR

(2) IN ANY MANNER OTHER THAN AS A FARM TRUCK.

(E) PENALTIES.

(1) ANY PERSON WHO OBTAINS A FARM TRUCK REGISTRATION THROUGH MISREPRESENTATION, FALSE PRETENSES, OR FRAUD IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS
