

THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT ISSUE ANY DRIVER'S LICENSE IF THE ~~APPLICANT~~ APPLICANT DOES NOT MEET THE STANDARDS OF THIS SECTION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Art. 66 1/2, §6-110.1.

In subsection (d)(1) of this section, the present phrase "with or without glasses" is deleted as unnecessary in light of subsection (b) of this section. Also, the present reference in the endorsement to an "applicant" is corrected to refer to the "holder" and the language of the endorsement is reordered for clarity.

Present §6-110.1(b), which relates to withholding a license until an applicant determines if substandard vision can be corrected, is deleted as superfluous.

The only other changes are in style.

#### 16-111. ISSUANCE OF LICENSE.

##### (A) WHEN APPLICANT ENTITLED TO RECEIVE.

AN APPLICANT IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE THE DRIVER'S LICENSE APPLIED FOR IF THE APPLICANT:

(1) PASSES THE EXAMINATION PROVIDED FOR IN THIS SUBTITLE;

(2) SURRENDERS THE LAST LEARNER'S PERMIT ISSUED TO HIM, IF ANY; AND

(3) PAYS THE FEES PROVIDED FOR BY THIS SUBTITLE.

##### (B) LICENSE TO BE IDENTIFIED AND NUMBERED.

(1) EACH LICENSE ISSUED BY THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL BE IDENTIFIED CLEARLY AS TO ITS SPECIFIC CLASS. A CLASS E LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED IN COMBINATION WITH ANY ONE OF THE OTHER CLASSES.

(2) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ASSIGN AN IDENTIFYING NUMBER TO EACH LICENSE IT ISSUES.

##### (C) FORM AND CONTENTS OF LICENSE.

EACH LICENSE ISSUED BY THE ADMINISTRATION:

(1) SHALL BE OF THE SIZE, DESIGN, AND CONTENT THAT THE ADMINISTRATION SPECIFIES; AND
