

SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF AN APPROVED DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAM, CONSISTING OF AT LEAST 30 HOURS OF CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION AND 6 HOURS OF LABORATORY INSTRUCTION;

(3) STANDARDS FOR THE CERTIFICATION OF SCHOOLS, CLASSROOM INSTRUCTORS, AND LABORATORY INSTRUCTORS;

(4) PROCEDURES FOR PAYMENT OF STATE REIMBURSEMENT BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND THE ADMINISTRATION FOR THEIR RESPECTIVE DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAMS;

(5) A SYSTEM TO EVALUATE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAM;

(6) STANDARDS GOVERNING THE REQUIRED OFFERING OF THE DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAM, BASED ON THE CAPACITY, ENROLLMENT, STAFF, AND FACILITIES OF THE SCHOOLS; AND

(7) STANDARDS FOR THE ELIGIBILITY OF INDIVIDUALS TO ENROLL IN THE PROGRAM.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Art. 66 1/2, §6-704.

In the introductory clause of subsection (b) of this section, the phrase "but not be limited to" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the definition of "include" in §1-101 of this article.

Item (b) (7) of this section is new language derived from the repeated references to "eligible individuals" and the implicit requirement that standards of eligibility be adopted.

The only other changes are in style.

As to subsection (b) (2) of this section, see also §16-103 of this title, which provides for an exception to the 6-hour laboratory instruction requirement under certain conditions.

16-507. REFUSAL, SUSPENSION, OR REVOCATION OF CERTIFICATION.

(A) IN GENERAL.

THE ADMINISTRATION MAY SUSPEND, REVOKE, OR REFUSE TO GRANT OR RENEW CERTIFICATION UNDER THE DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAM OF ANY DRIVERS' SCHOOL OR OF ANY CLASSROOM OR LABORATORY INSTRUCTOR OF A DRIVERS' SCHOOL, IF IT FINDS THAT THE SCHOOL OR INSTRUCTOR HAS FAILED TO COMPLY WITH ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF OR ANY RULE OR REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER:
