(C) BUSINESS DISTRICT.

"BUSINESS DISTRICT" MEANS AN AREA THAT ADJOINS AND INCLUDES A HIGHWAY WHERE AT LEAST 50 PERCENT OF THE FRONTAGE ALONG THE HIGHWAY, FOR A DISTANCE OF AT LEAST 300 FEET, IS OCCUPIED BY BUILDINGS USED FOR BUSINESS.

(D) CONTROLLED ACCESS HIGHWAY.

"CONTROLLED ACCESS HIGHWAY" MEANS A HIGHWAY OR ROADWAY TO OR FROM WHICH PERSONS, INCLUDING THE OWNERS OR OCCUPANTS OF ABUTTING LANDS, HAVE NO RIGHT OF ACCESS EXCEPT AT THE POINTS AND IN THE MANNER DETERMINED BY THE PUBLIC AUTHORITY WITH JURISDICTION OVER THE HIGHWAY OR ROADWAY.

(E) CROSSOVER.

"CROSSOVER" MEANS A TRANSVERSE ROADWAY OR OPENING THAT CONNECTS THE SEPARATE ROADWAYS OF A DIVIDED HIGHWAY AT A POINT OTHER THAN AN INTERSECTION OF THE DIVIDED HIGHWAY WITH ANOTHER HIGHWAY.

(F) CROSSWALK.

"CROSSWALK" MEANS:
