AT THE EXPENSE OF THE OWNER OR OCCUPANT.

- (B) IF THE OWNER FAILS TO REPAY THE COUNTY FOR EXPENSES INCURRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER WRITTEN DEMAND HAS BEEN MAILED TO HIS LAST KNOWN ADDRESS, THE DIRECTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE COLLECTOR OF TAXES FOR PREDERICK COUNTY AND A TAX LIEN IN FAVOR OF THE COUNTY FOR THE AMOUNT OF THE EXPENSES INCURRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) SHALL ATTACH TO THE PROPERTY.
- (C) THE PROPERTY MAY BE SOLD AT TAX SALE TO SATISFY A LIEN AUTHORIZED BY THIS SECTION.

3-9.

- (A) ANY PERSON WHC KNOWINGLY FAILS TO COMPLY WITH AN ORDER ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBHEADING SHALL BE FINED NOT MORE THAN \$100 OR IMPRISONED NOT MORE THAN TEN DAYS OR BOTH.
- (B) EACH DAY WHICH A PERSON KNOWINGLY FAILS TO COMPLY WITH AN ORDER ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBHEADING SHALL BE DEEMED A SEPARATE OFFENSE.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.
