CHAPTER 97

{House Bill 166}

AN ACT concerning

Hunters - Wearing Apparel

FOR the purpose of specifying certain daylight fluorescent clothing that certain persons hunting deer or with a hunter are required to wear.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Natural Resources
Section 10-415(e)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1974 Volume and 1977 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources

10-415.

(e) Any person who hunts deer and any person who accompanies, aids, or assists another person hunting deer, shall wear [or display in a conspicuous manner on his head, chest, or back, clothing or material] EITHER A CAP, VEST, OR JACKET OR A JACKET CONTAINING BACK AND FRONT PANELS of a daylight fluorescent orange color. This section does not apply to any person who hunts on his property without a hunter's license nor to any person hunting deer with a bow and arrow during the season restricted to hunting with a bow and arrow.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.
