CHAPTER 106

(House Bill 210)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Temporary Registrations

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Administration to issue temporary registration plates to certain vehicles pending action by the Administration on the registration application; providing for a fee to be charged for issuance of a temporary registration plate; limiting the period of time for which temporary registration may be issued; and deleting certain superfluous and unnecessary language.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

[(a)] As to any vehicle required to be registered under this title, a person may not drive the vehicle on any highway in this State and the owner of the vehicle may not knowingly permit it to be driven on any highway in this
