TITLE 4. LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION.

SUBTITLE 1. COUNTY BOARDS OF EDUCATION.

4-101. CONTROL AND PROMOTION OF EDUCATION.

(A) CONTROL OF EDUCATIONAL MATTERS.

EDUCATIONAL MATTERS THAT AFFECT THE COUNTIES SHALL BE UNDER THE CONTROL OF A COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION IN EACH COUNTY.

(B) PROMOTION OF SCHOOLS.

EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL SEEK IN EVERY WAY TO PROMOTE THE INTERESTS OF THE SCHOOLS UNDER ITS JURISDICTION.
