

(a) A bailiff shall receive the compensation provided in this section. Unless otherwise provided, the amount is a per diem sum for each day he attends the circuit court.

CHAPTER 168

(House Bill 1869)

AN ACT concerning

Caroline County - State's Attorney

FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the State's Attorney of Caroline County; providing the Caroline County State's Attorney shall receive expenses as provided by the State Standard Travel Regulations rather than of a fixed amount; permitting the State's Attorney to appoint and set the salary of assistant State's attorneys, subject to the approval of the County Commissioners; permitting the State's Attorney and the assistant State's attorneys to engage in the private practice of law under certain circumstances; and providing that the salary change does not affect the incumbent.
