- (II) SHALL CONFORM WITH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF COMPREHENSIVE LIABILITY INSURANCE POLICIES AVAILABLE IN THE PRIVATE MARKET.
  - (D) DEFENSE OF SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY.
- (1) A COUNTY BOARD MAY RAISE THE DEFENSE OF SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY TO ANY AMOUNT CLAIMED ABOVE THE LIMIT OF ITS INSURANCE POLICY OR, IF SELF-INSURED, ABOVE \$100,000.
- (2) A COUNTY BOARD MAY NOT RAISE THE DEFENSE OF SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY TO ANY CLAIM OF \$100,000 OR LESS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Art. 77, §56B.

In subsection (a) of this section, the present reference to the "Board of School Commissioners of Baltimore City" is deleted in light of the definition of "county board" in §1-101 of this article.

4-106. MEETINGS; OFFICERS; EXPENSES.

(A) BALTIMORE CITY EXCEPTED.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO BALTIMORE CITY.

(B) ANNUAL MEETING.

EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL HOLD AN ANNUAL MEETING ON OR AS NEAR AS POSSIBLE TO THE SECOND TUESDAY IN JULY EXCEPT THAT:

- (1) IN ALLEGANY COUNTY, THE ANNUAL MEETING SHALL BE HELD ON THE SECOND TUESDAY OF JANUARY;
- (2) IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, THE ANNUAL MEETING SHALL BE HELD ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 10; AND
- (3) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, THE ANNUAL MEETING SHALL BE HELD ON THE FIRST MONDAY IN DECEMBER.
  - (C) OTHER BEETINGS.

A COUNTY BOARD MAY HOLD ANY OTHER MEETINGS THAT ITS DUTIES AND BUSINESS REQUIRE.

(D) ELECTION OF OFFICERS.
