SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 31B - Patuxent Institution

15.

Upon the approval [of the Board of Public Works] AS REQUIRED BY LAW, the director of Paturent Institution may apply for and receive from the federal government or any board, bureau, commission, department or other agency thereof any funds, chattels, or foodstuffs by way of grant or loan that may be available to be used in the establishment, maintenance or program of the Institution.

Article 15A -- Budget and Fiscal Planning

Any gift or legacy OR OTHER DONATION, GRANT, OR LOAN, WHETHER PERMANENT OR TEMPORARY, coming into the hands of any department, board, commission, officer or institution of the State, may be utilized in accordance with the terms of such gift [or], legacy, DONATION, GRANT, OR LOAN [provided] IF the Governor [shall have] previously HAS assented to the acceptance of such gift [or], legacy, DONATION, GRANT, OR LOAN.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.
