

~~said board of trustees shall determine the form of the bonds, including any interest coupons to be attached thereto, and shall fix the denomination or denominations of the bonds and the place or places of payment of principal and interest which may be at any bank or trust company within or without the State. The bonds shall bear the manual or facsimile signature of the chairman or one of the other members of the said board of trustees and the official seal of the said board of trustees or a facsimile thereof shall be affixed to said bonds, attested by the manual or facsimile signature of the secretary or an assistant secretary of said board of trustees, provided that at least one of said signatures with respect to each of said bonds shall be a manual signature, and any coupons attached thereto shall bear the facsimile signature of the chairman of said board of trustees. In case any officer whose signature or a facsimile of whose signature shall appear on any bonds or coupons shall cease to be such officer before the delivery of such bonds, such signature or such facsimile shall nevertheless be valid and sufficient for all purposes the same as if he had remained in office until such delivery. All bonds issued under the provisions of §§ 14N-14K, inclusive, of this subtitle shall have and are hereby declared to have all the qualities and incidents of negotiable instruments under the Negotiable Instrument Law of the State. The bonds may be issued in coupon or in registered form, or both, as said board of trustees may determine, and provision may be made for the registration of any coupon bonds as to principal alone and also as to both principal and interest, and for the reconversion into coupon bonds of any bonds registered as to both principal and interest. Said board of trustees may sell such bonds in such manner, either at public or private sale, and for such price or prices, as it may determine to be for the best interests of the State.~~
