(a) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(2) "EMERGENCY SERVICES" MEANS FIRE, RESCUE, AND AMBULANCE SERVICES.

(3) [In this section] "Schools" means the Maryland Fire and Rescue Institute, any emergency services training academy operated by any city, county, or municipal government, any community college offering emergency services education and training courses, any public school offering emergency services education and training courses, and any private or governmental institution or body providing emergency services education and training courses.

(c) (1) The Commission consists of 11 members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. Of the members:

(i) Each shall be qualified to deal with the matters within the authority of the Commission;

(ii) Five shall be volunteer [fire or rescue] EMERGENCY SERVICES personnel or [fire and rescue] instructors;

(iii) Three shall be [fire and rescue] EMERGENCY SERVICES instructors who are [professional fire or rescue] CAREER personnel representing the academies.
