

Annotated Code of Maryland  
(As enacted by Chapter \_\_\_\_ of the Acts

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland (as enacted by Chapter \_\_\_\_ of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1978) be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Education

18-603.

(c) (1) A child may apply to the State Scholarship Board for a scholarship under this section if his parent was a member of the armed forces[, ] and THE PARENT WAS A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE AT THE TIME THE PARENT:

(i) [Was a resident of this State at the time of his induction and died] DIED or was totally and permanently disabled as a result of military service after December 7, 1941; or

(ii) Was declared to be a prisoner of war or missing in action, IF THAT OCCURRED on or after January 1, 1960 as a result of the Vietnam conflict, and [was a resident of this State at the time he was so declared,] if the child was born while the parent was a prisoner of war or missing in action.

(b) Any resident of this State may apply to the State Scholarship Board under this section if he:

(1) Was a prisoner of war on or after January 1, 1960 as a result of the Vietnam conflict; and

(2) Was a resident of this State at the time [of his induction into the armed forces] HE WAS DECLARED TO BE A PRISONER OF WAR OR DECLARED TO BE MISSING IN ACTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1978.

CHAPTER 284

(Senate Bill 1031)

AN ACT concerning
