SERVES UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

CHAPTER 286

(Senate Bill 1077)

AN ACT concerning

Insurance - Protest Procedure

FOR the purpose of revising the hearing procedure whereby the Maryland Insurance Commissioner considers a protest filed by an insured concerning the cancellation, nonrenewal, increase in premium or reduction of coverage in his motor vehicle liability insurance policy; authorizing the Commissioner to determine without a hearing the merits of an insured's protest and to take the appropriate action relating thereto; requiring the Commissioner to send written notice of his action; allowing the aggrieved party the right to a hearing on the action; setting the time and procedures for the hearing; providing that the insurer has the burden of proof; and relating generally to the procedure for determining the merits of an insured's protest to certain changes in his motor vehicle liability insurance policy.
