## Article - Education

18-605.

(b) Any professional or volunteer fireman or rescue squad member is entitled to reimbursement by the State Scholarship Board for tuition costs for courses credited toward a degree in fire service technology OR EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY.
